

## **California Residents:**

### **As a California resident, you have the following rights:**

1. **Right to Know:** You may submit a request that we disclose to you the categories of personal information we collect, the sources from which we collect that personal information, the business or commercial purpose for collecting personal information, categories of third parties with which we disclose personal information, and the specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you, or to access information related to an automated decision. You also have the right to know criteria used to determine the period of time for which we intend to retain each category of personal information, including sensitive personal information.
2. **Right to Delete Data:** You may submit a request that we delete or remove certain personal information that we may have collected about you, as long as we are not otherwise obligated or permitted to retain or use that information for a lawful purpose. If we reject your request, we will notify you of the reason(s) for the rejection.
3. **Right to Correct:** You have the right to request that we correct inaccurate personal information we may have about you.
4. **Right to Non-Discrimination:** You have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment for the exercise of your privacy rights.
5. **Rights Related to the Sale and Sharing of your Personal Information:** You have the right to be notified at or before the point of collection what categories of sensitive personal information the Agency collects about you and the purposes for which it is collected or used, and whether your personal information is "sold" or "shared" as those terms are defined in the CCPA and to opt out of such sale or sharing; *we do not sell your personal information or share your sensitive personal information as defined under the CCPA.*

## **Colorado Residents:**

A consumer has the right to request in writing that a debt collector or collection agency cease further communication with the consumer. A written request to cease communication will not prohibit the debt collector or collection agency from taking any other action authorized by law to collect the debt.
